mise en abyme's latest album, *Do You Hear The Hum*, further explores their unique mix of analog and digital music with 12 new, genre-bending songs sure to pique the interest of music fans of anything from classical guitar pieces to **Brian Eno** solo albums. *Do You Hear The Hum* has plenty of great organic electronic music, but new to this album is the addition of band member **Jesquibel** and live drums by **Adrian Orange** of **Thanksgiving**. Described by the band as techno noir, the album contains both clean and dirty-sounding tracks that range from mellow electronic like **The Books** to edgy guitar rock like **Radiohead** to poppy New Wave like the **Talking Heads**.

Do You Hear The Hum is **mise en abyme's** third album, following *Crochet* and *Jesquibel* which were both released on **Marriage Records**. The song "Reaching" from *Jesquibel* was featured on **BBC 3's Mixing It**. **mise en abyme** has also created soundtrack music, most recently for **Gideon Klindt's** video art piece called *Cat and Cake* which was featured at the 2005 **Portland Film Festival** and was chosen for inclusion in the book **Northwest Edge: The Edge of Reality**. Also, newest member **Jesquibel** wrote the music for the film **Speed Dating** to air on the **Independent Film Channel** for the month of August 2006. In August 2005, **mise en abyme** toured with **Adrian Orange** of **Thanksgiving**, both performing as **Thanksgiving's** back-up band and featuring **Adrian** on drums during their own set.
